Hotel Room Confirmations

Hotel room confirmations will be sent via email from **Trina Ellis**—Oklahoma City Convention & Visitor's Bureau (OKCCVB). In some cases, room confirmations may be emailed to your state or area conference POC for distribution. If no email address is available, confirmations will be sent via postal mail.

Hotel Room Deadlines

Rooms at any of the conference hotels not reserved by **Monday, 02 July** will be released to the general attendee block. You may still reserve a room until **Sunday, 15 July** under the general attendee block. The location of rooms blocked from the period of 03 July until 15 July will depend upon the conference hotel that has rooms available. On **Monday, 16 July** all unreserved rooms will be returned to the hotels.

Hotel Room Cancellations

Hotel room cancellations requested after **31 July 2007** will result in the forfeit of a one-night's stay payment plus applicable taxes (*you will be charged for one-night's hotel stay plus taxes that apply*).

Transportation will be provided—

For conferees arriving for the conference via commercial air flights to their respective hotels—members of the Oklahoma Auxiliary will be on hand to assist association members to welcome you. Luggage will travel on a separate vehicle. You will be provided with ribbons for your luggage for color-coding before it is placed onto the vehicle to ensure it is delivered to the correct hotel (i.e.—luggage going to the Sheraton Hotel will have yellow ribbons).

Conferees departing the conference to travel home via commercial air flights will also have transportation available to them. You will need to coordinate a scheduled time of pick-up from your hotel at the registration check-in.

Attendance to 2007 EANGUS Round-Up scheduled off-site event venues. If you travel to the conference in your POV and wish to travel to the Sunday Night Welcome event (National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum) in your vehicle, parking is available and free.

There will be a two-person staff at each hotel to ensure that you are offered every available amenity. You will not need to have any direct contact with hotel personnel.

First Timer's Meeting

Entertainment/Special Events

Sunday Night Welcome (National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum)—Musical “Oklahoma”.

Monday night— (Oklahoma Red Hawks Ball Park) activities are planned to include a “*special dedication*” to the Men and Women in Uniform prior to the first pitch.

The Oklahoma EANGUS 2007 Round-Up Committee has acquired 5000 tickets for this spectacular event.

The opening entertainment will be provided by the Oklahoma Governor’s National Guard Band. The event is scheduled to take place from 6 -7 p.m.

Following the event, transportation will be offered to persons interested in a visit to one of the casinos, the National Memorial and more. You may wish to enjoy the comfortable walk to Bricktown where you are offered endless eateries/entertainment to include a canal ride.

Also on Monday night (as previously published), Area IV will host a Lip Sync/Costume contest geared to the 70’s 80’s and 90’s beginning at 8 p.m. (*Dress in fashions from the era of your choice*).

Tuesday

Auxiliary Luncheon/Awards Program

There is no provision to sign-up to attend the Auxiliary Luncheon at the conference; you will need to indicate your intent on your conference registration form. There are no ticket sales—the Luncheon is **free.**

If you are not certain that you have indicated that you plan to attend the Luncheon on Tuesday, you should contact your state president or the designated POC for your state/area *or* me to ensure that your registration form indicates that you and your spouse or any other conference registrant plan to do so. If you have special circumstances regarding food (allergies), please let me know.

You must have paid the conference registration fee which entitles you to attend all of the inclusive events whether you will attend all of the events or not. There is no provision for persons to pay for attendance to specific events.

Tuesday—The “All Area Hospitality Night” will be held in the air-conditioned Exhibit Hall 3 at the Cox Convention Center. Entertainment will be provided by the Jimmy Buffet “*Tribute Band*”.

Wednesday— Conferees will enjoy the musical entertainment of Krystal Keith (daughter of Country/Western star, Tobey) at the Banquet on Wednesday night (Cox Convention Center-Second Level).

Dress code for the Banquet is formal attire.

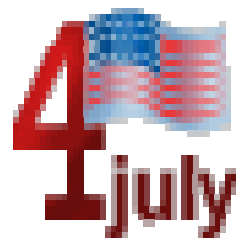
